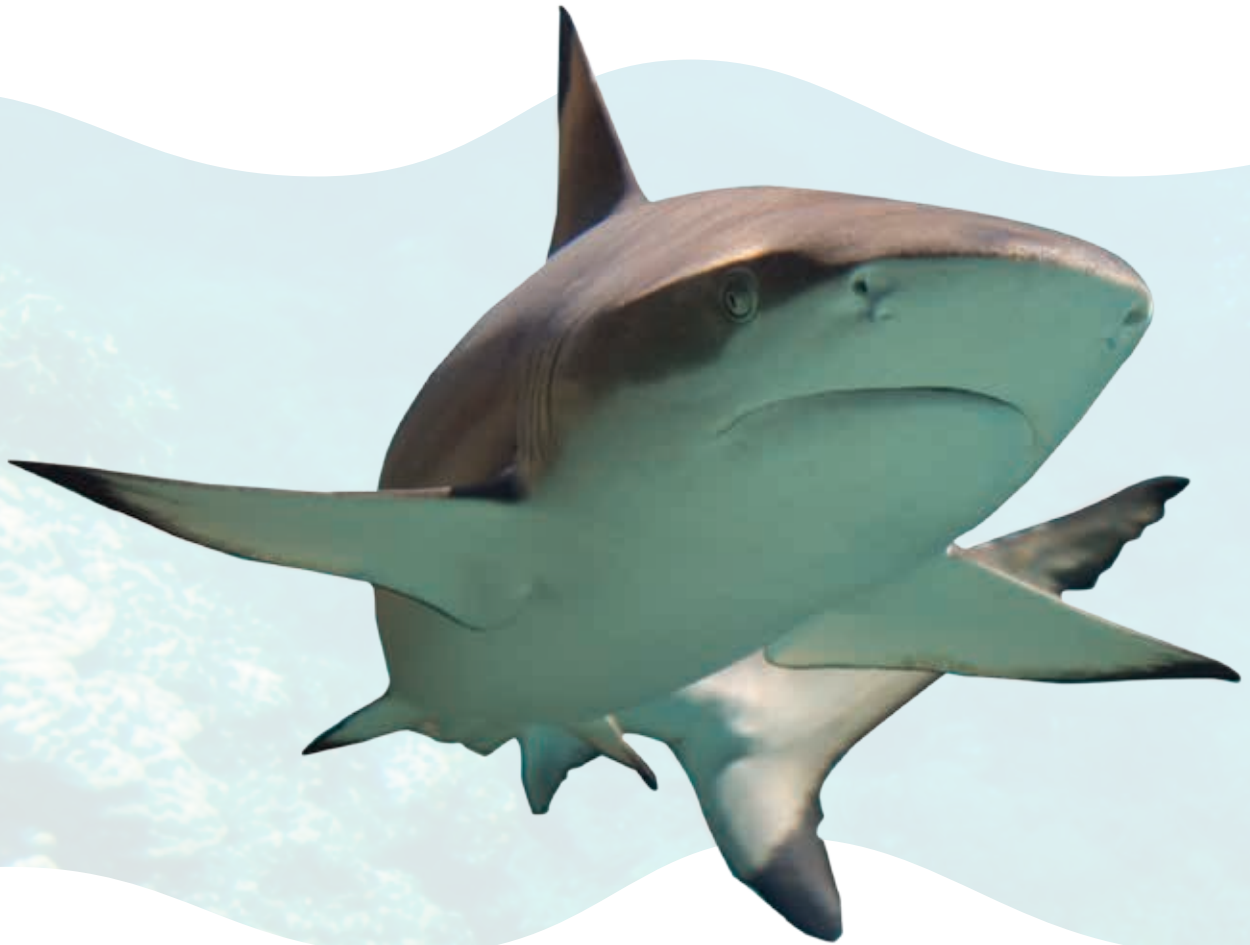

All sharks are not the same. This shark is very little, but it still has sharp teeth. Its bite may hurt.

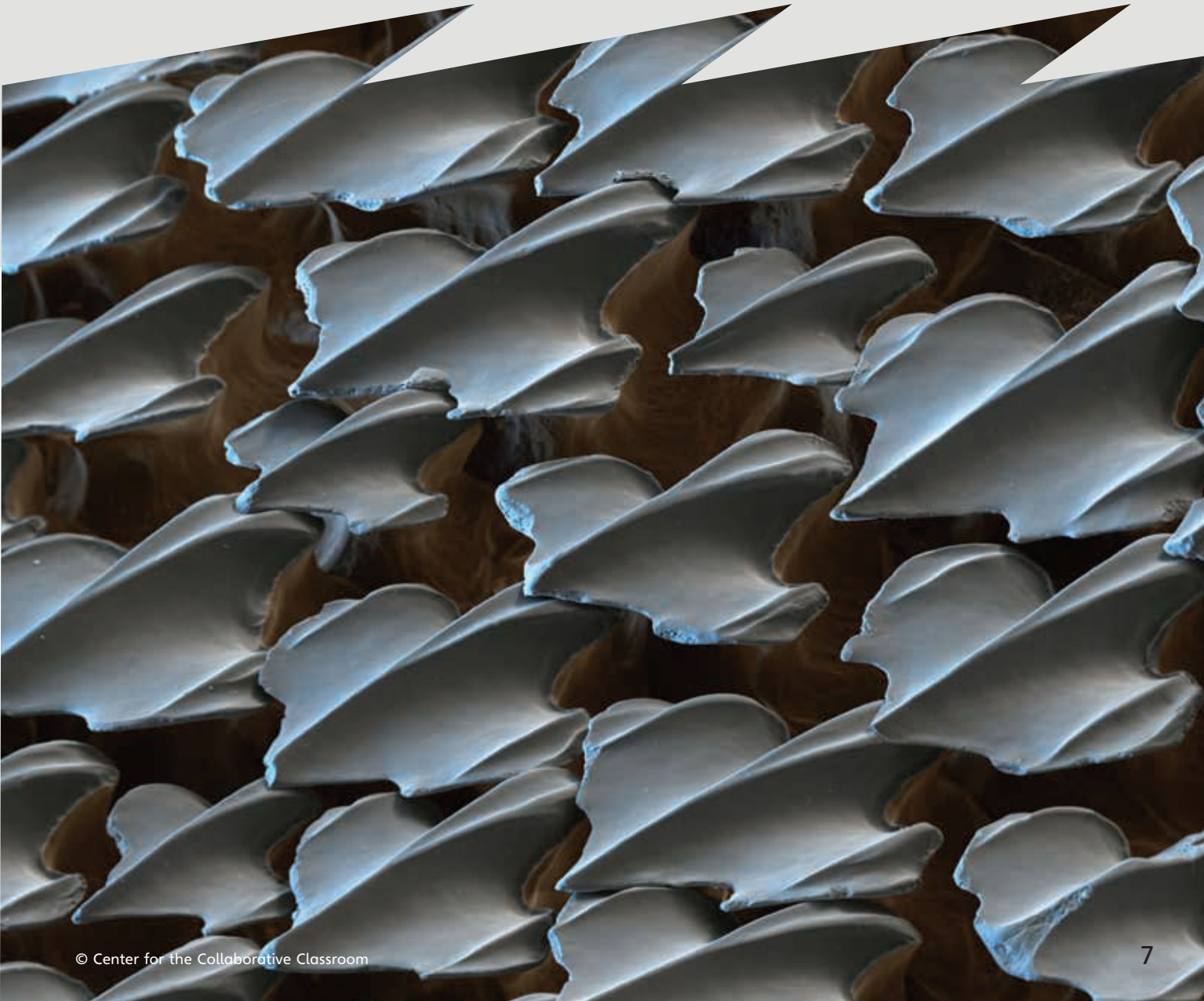


This shark is very, very big. It has teeth,

have flat scales all over them.

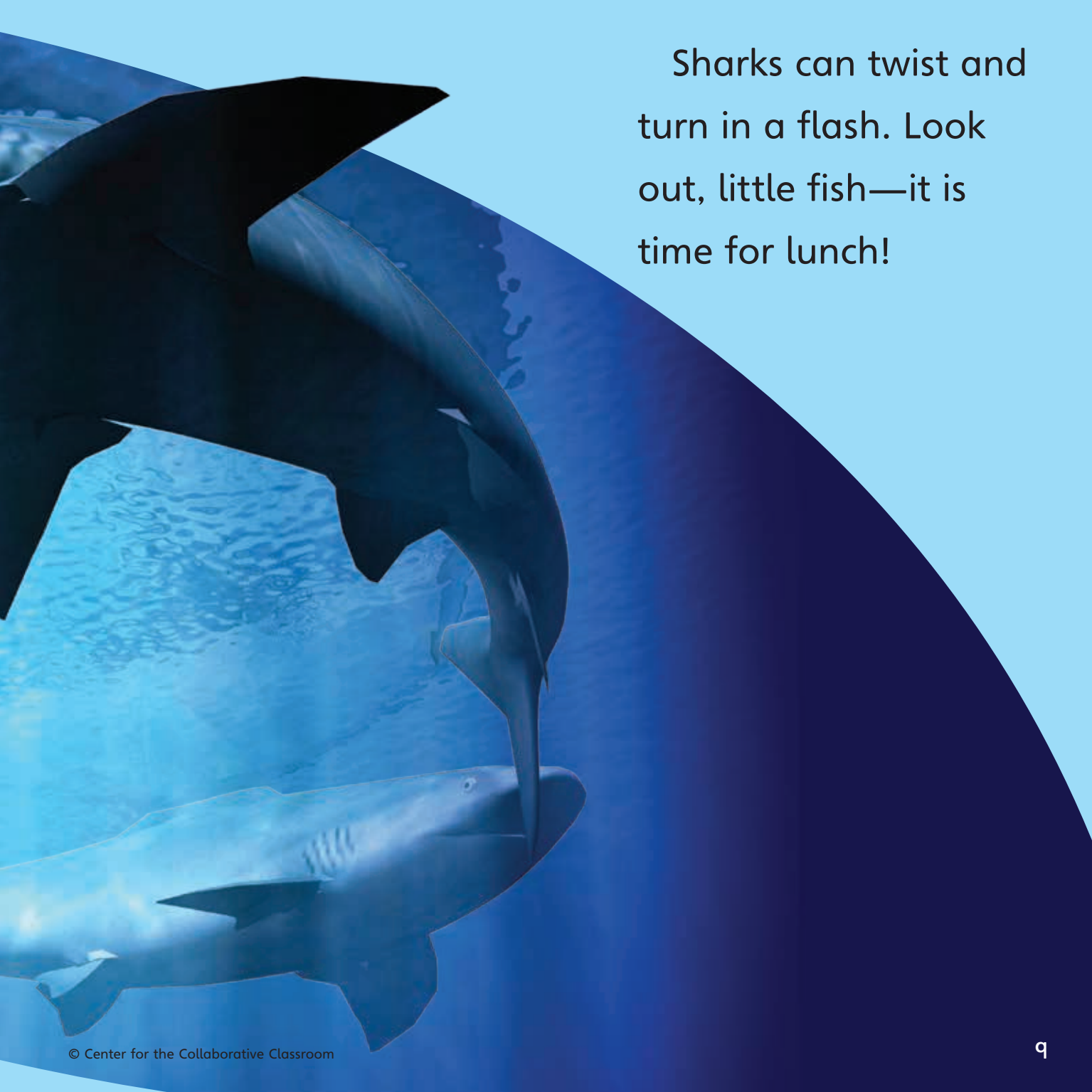
Up close, shark scales look like thorns.
