Some clowns can be fat and some can be slim. Clowns have many skills. They should do many tricks.



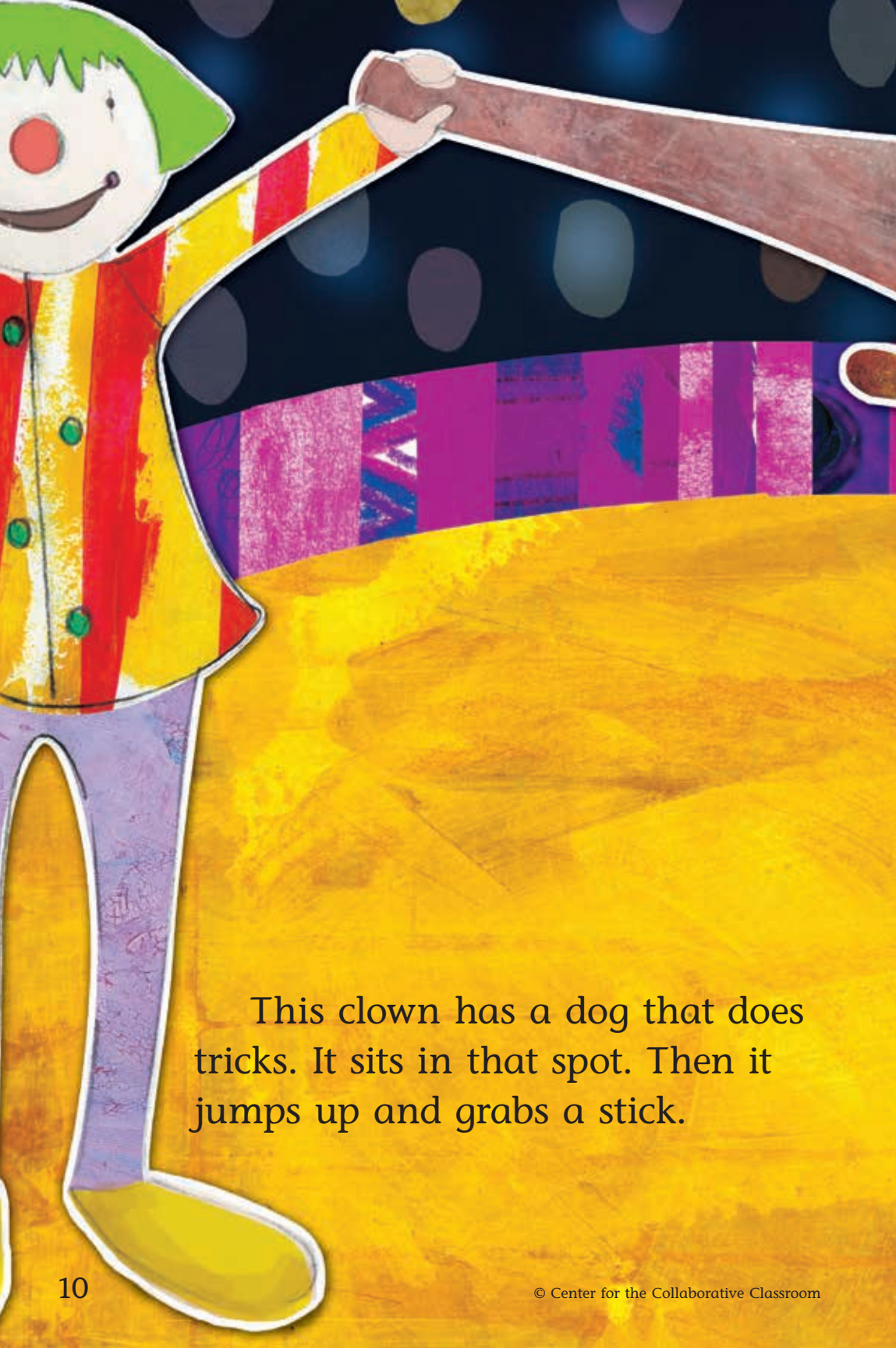


This clown does many fun tricks. She can skip and spin. She can flip and flop.

This clown has a dog that does tricks. It sits in that spot. Then it jumps up and grabs a stick.

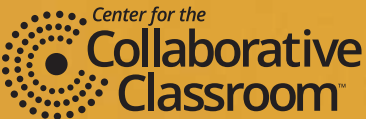




Look at what this clown can do.
