
Up <u>and Down</u> the Hill: <u>Part</u> 3





Riff did not kill <u>the</u> skunk. <u>He</u> did not <u>like</u> <u>the</u> bad smell.




Sam <u>said</u>, "<u>Look</u> at Riff rub <u>on the</u> grass. <u>Look</u> at him lick his legs."


